To be eligible to become a member you must:

- Be invited by maintaining a 3.5 Grade Point Average out of a 4.0 Scale
- Get involved in co-curricular activities
- Be a well rounded student and a Positive Leader
- Must be a sophomore or junior
- Must have application returned on time to Mrs. Page or Ms. Farrell

How to become a member once you apply:

- An anonymous board is formed made up of teachers from different departments
- Each student who turned in an application in time is then rated by each teacher in the building based on the qualities above.
- Once all students have been rated the anonymous board comes to a consensus about a point average each student must receive in order to become a member of Chesapeake High School's National Honor Society

Requirements once you are a member:

- Must maintain a 3.5 Grade Point Average out of a 4.0 Scale
- Must tutor twice in the high school and once at the middle school per semester
- Must complete service learning points (i.e. Toys for Tots, Canned Food Drive)
- Must attend a meeting on the first Monday of every month
- Must uphold the qualities of Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Character throughout your membership of the Chesapeake High National Honor Society
