- I. Maryland Education Law provides that subject to the applicable provisions of this article and the bylaws, basic policies, and guidelines established by the State Board, the Board, on the written recommendation of the Superintendent, shall:
 - A. establish curriculum guides and courses of study for the schools under its jurisdiction, including appropriate programs of instruction or training for mentally or physically handicapped children; and
 - B. supply printed copies of curriculum guides and courses of study to any teacher or interested citizen.
 - II. In addition, Maryland Education Law provides that the Superintendent shall prepare and recommend for adoption by the Board:
 - A. curriculum guides;
 - B. courses of study;
 - C. resource material; and
 - D. other teaching aids.
 - III. Teachers will organize the instructional program in accordance with the most recent curriculum documents issued for use in the county.
 - IV. No course of study will be offered without prior approval of the Board during a regular meeting.
 - V. Approved courses of study will not be changed in substance or content without Board approval.
