  - II. All supplemental instructional materials required by the course of study will be supported by public funds and will remain the property of the Board.
  - III. Selection and adoption of supplemental materials will be the responsibility of members of each content area's standing committee, appointed by the Director of Curriculum and chaired by the respective program coordinator. The work of the committee will be governed by procedures established by the Board and published in the Procedures for the Evaluation and Selection of Instructional Materials manual.
