

# POLICY BOARD OF EDUCATION OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

## GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

### A. PURPOSE

To establish the requirements for students graduating with a Maryland High School Diploma from Anne Arundel County Public Schools.

### B. ISSUE

State law requires that students who graduate from a Maryland public high school must meet all requirements established in COMAR regulations and any local requirements established beyond the minimum state requirements.

### C. POSITION

1. Graduation requirements for students attending Anne Arundel County Public Schools shall be administered in accordance with the bylaws of the Maryland State Board of Education, subject to any modifications permitted by law.
2. The Board of Education will establish the number of required credits for graduation from a public high school in Anne Arundel County in excess of the minimum number of credits required by the Maryland State Board of Education for graduation from a public high school.

### D. IMPLEMENTATION

The Superintendent is authorized to develop regulations to implement the policy.
