- I. With the exceptions of field trips and vocational programs, school buses serve solely to transport students between their schools and their designated bus stops.
 - II. Principals or designees may assign pupils to designated bus stops. Students must use the designated bus stops unless otherwise directed by the principal or designee.
 - III. Students will be discharged only at their designated stops or at their schools.
 - IV. Students may not be deprived of bus service as a means of returning home once they are in school unless the school provides them with transportation or the parents agree to accept the responsibility.
