- I. Prior to selection, purchase, and installation, a Parent Teacher Association or any interested group desiring to purchase and install playground equipment for a school must obtain the approval of the school principal, the Coordinator of Physical Education and Athletics, and the grounds foreperson of the Maintenance Division, who will appraise the proposal from the standpoint of educational value and safety. The proposal must also include the location on the school property where equipment is to be installed.

 - II. The installation of approved playground equipment purchased by a Parent Teacher Association or any interested group will normally be accomplished by approved installers. Prior to equipment acceptance, the Supervisor of Maintenance approves installation of the equipment for the purchasing group. Prior to installation, the installer will provide drawings, specifications, insurance certificates, warranty, and all other pertinent information to the grounds division. The grounds division will inspect all work performed by the installer to ensure the quality of workmanship, and will accept or reject all work upon completion.
