Description

Principles of Technology Leadership is a 1 MSDE credit, **online** learning course designed for prospective and practicing administrators who wish to develop an understanding of technology leadership and best practices that will lead to effective technology integration and improved student learning. Participants will examine how software and electronic resources can assist their school-improvement teams in the data-driven decision-making process to enhance and differentiate instruction and investigate hardware and software for integration into the K-12 curricula.

In order to succeed in the Principles of Technology Leadership Course, you must be technology literate. During the Proficiency Orientation Workshop you will be provided with a **self-assessment** that will help you determine your specific needs.

For those who may need some “review” prior to taking the Principles of Technology Leadership, we recommend the following course that consists of four, 3-hour workshops:

Administrator’s Toolbox is a 1 credit MSDE course designed for administrators who would like to explore various tools and strategies for streamlining daily administrative tasks and processes. These face-to-face course sessions may be taken individually or together as a 1 credit package, depending on need. These courses include:

- Introduction to MS Word
- PowerPoint for Administrators
- Online Communication Tools
- Introduction to Excel
- E-Portfolios

Requirements

All participants will be required to attend a **Proficiency Orientation Workshop**. This informal, 2 hr. Hors d’oeuvres meeting will introduce school leaders to this innovative program, as well as allow them to identify their personal “track” for this program.



Participants interested on the online course, **Principles of Technology Leadership** should possess:

- a willingness to learn independently and to work within a new interface
- ability to navigate the web, multi-task, & send email with attachment
