Call for Nominations: Anne Arundel County Public Schools

Attached is nomination information for *The Washington Post Distinguished Educational Leadership Awards* (for principals) and *The Agnes Meyer Outstanding Teacher Awards*.

What should be included in the nomination package? Carefully read the information in the Washington Post flyer. Your nomination should address each of the nomination criteria. Nomination materials **must** include the following:

- Cover sheet which includes:
 - Nominee name and school
 - Name, telephone, and email of the person submitting the nomination
- A minimum of four statements of support, one of which must be from a professional educator
- A career summary
- A description of contributions in each of the five nomination criteria. We recommend that the description be no more than five pages, double-spaced, typed on 8 ½ inch by 11 inch white paper.
- ***Optional:*** Two color photographs. Photos should include one head shot and one ‘action shot’ of the nominee at work. We will work with *the winner* to submit appropriate photos to The Washington Post.

Deadline for Submission: Friday, January 13, 2012, no later than 4:00 p.m. (NO EXCEPTIONS)

Email submissions are strongly encouraged. Email submissions should be sent in either Microsoft Word format or as a .pdf file. Put the words “Washington Post Nomination” in the subject line and email to DevOffice@aacps.org .

Hard copies should be hand-delivered to the AACPS Development Office, Dr. Carol Sheffey Parham Building (Central Office), 2644 Riva Road, Annapolis, Maryland 21401.

An awards ceremony for each program will be held at *The Washington Post* in May 2012.
