DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A TEACHER OF THE YEAR NOMINATION

OVERVIEW

The Anne Arundel County Excellence in Education/Teacher of the Year (EIE/TOY) nomination process has changed! Read the directions carefully before submitting a nomination.

There are now three rounds for the Anne Arundel County EIE/TOY competition:

- ROUND ONE: Nomination of teachers
- ROUND TWO: Selection of 15 semi-finalists
- ROUND THREE: Selection of five finalists

The Teacher of the Year (one for public schools and one for private schools) will be announced in April 2010 at the Teacher of the Year Ceremony.

The Public School Teacher of the Year will compete in the Maryland State Teacher of the Year competition.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ROUND ONE SUBMISSION

CRITERIA FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL NOMINATIONS

- The nominee must have completed five years of teaching in Anne Arundel County Public Schools.
- The nominee must remain as a teacher during the year of tenure as AACPS Teacher of the Year.
- Nominations may be made by anyone, with one exception: A teacher may not nominate himself or herself.

CRITERIA FOR PRIVATE SCHOOL NOMINATIONS

- The nominee must have completed five years of teaching in Anne Arundel County.
- The nominee must remain as a teacher during the year of tenure as Private School Teacher of the Year.
- Nominations may be made by anyone, with one exception: A teacher may not nominate himself or herself.

THE NOMINATION PACKET MUST INCLUDE, IN THIS ORDER:

- ① A cover letter (no more than one page) which includes:
 - a description of what makes the nominee an outstanding teacher and the best candidate for Teacher of the Year
 - the signature of the person nominating the teacher.
- ② A one-page description of the teacher's philosophy of teaching, written by the teacher. For example, describe the teacher's beliefs about teaching and what he/she believes makes him/her an outstanding teacher. Discuss how the teacher's beliefs are demonstrated in his/her personal teaching style.
- ③ A completed and signed Information Form, which is included in this nomination packet.
- ④ A completed and signed Statement of Agreement for All Local Teachers of the Year, which is included in this packet (public school nominees only).
- ⑤ A professional résumé that includes education, community service, and other awards and recognitions.

All nomination packets must be typed on standard 8-1/2 by 11 inch white paper. The document should have 1-inch margins and be single spaced, using Times New Roman 12-point font. All pages of the nomination packet should be paper-clipped. Please: Do not staple, bind, or put into a notebook.

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THESE ARE REASONS THAT NOMINATIONS MAY BE DEEMED INELIGIBLE:

- The packet arrives after 4 p.m. on Monday, February 1, 2010.
- The nominee does not meet the eligibility criteria as outlined in this nomination packet.
- The packet does not contain all of the required information as outlined in this nomination packet.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

ROUND ONE

A judging committee composed of educators and community leaders will read and evaluate each nomination packet. The evaluation rubric is included in this nomination packet. Semi-finalists will be notified by February 12, 2010.

ROUND TWO

Semi-finalists will receive and complete a more detailed nomination packet, which will be due on March 12, 2010. A judging committee composed of educators and community leaders will read and evaluate each nomination packet. Five finalists will be announced by the week of March 20, 2010.

ROUND THREE

Finalists will be interviewed on March 25–26 by a panel of educators and community leaders. The panel will choose the Anne Arundel County Teacher of the Year. The Teacher of the Year (both public and private school) will be announced at the EIE/TOY ceremony in April 2010.

I will also compete for the National Teacher of the Year and acknowledge that if selected as the National Teacher of the Year, I will be released from classroom responsibilities during the year of my recognition in order to fulfill the obligations inherent in the honor. (The release will be offered with full pay negotiated by MSDE & the local school system.)
