

## USNA Advanced Study Program Temporary Vehicle Pass Application

Under current procedures, vehicles are allowed to enter USNA if either (a) the vehicle displays a valid DoD decal and the driver (or a passenger) shows a current DoD ID or (b) the driver shows a current temporary pass that has been issued for that driver and that vehicle. In order to obtain a temporary vehicle pass for the upcoming session of the USNA Advanced Study Program, you are required to provide the information below. You may submit this application by hand-*printing* the information and mailing it to the address at the bottom of this sheet. If you prefer, use a computer to create an electronic document containing all this information and then either print and mail it (address below) or email the document to [mwc@usna.edu](mailto:mwc@usna.edu). It can take four or more work days after a completed application is received at USNA until vehicle passes are mailed to the family home address on record at the AACO Public Schools G&T Office. So make sure your vehicle pass application arrives at USNA **no later than 22 July 2005**.
