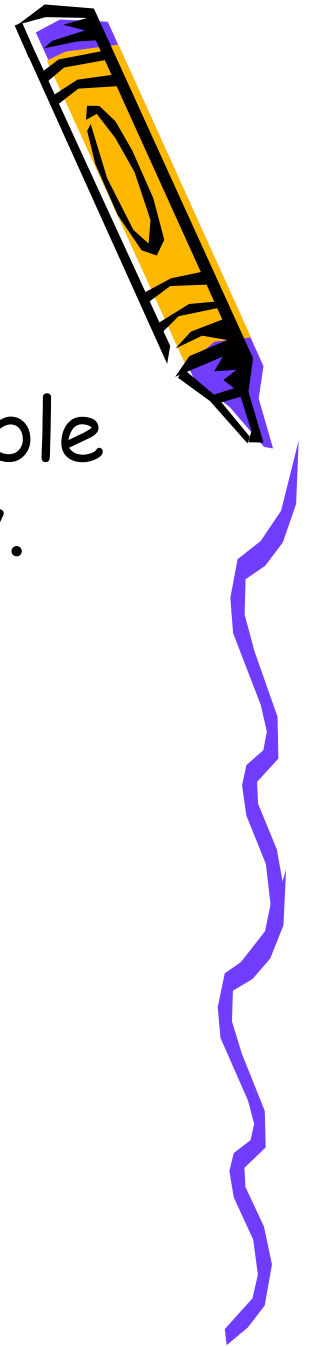

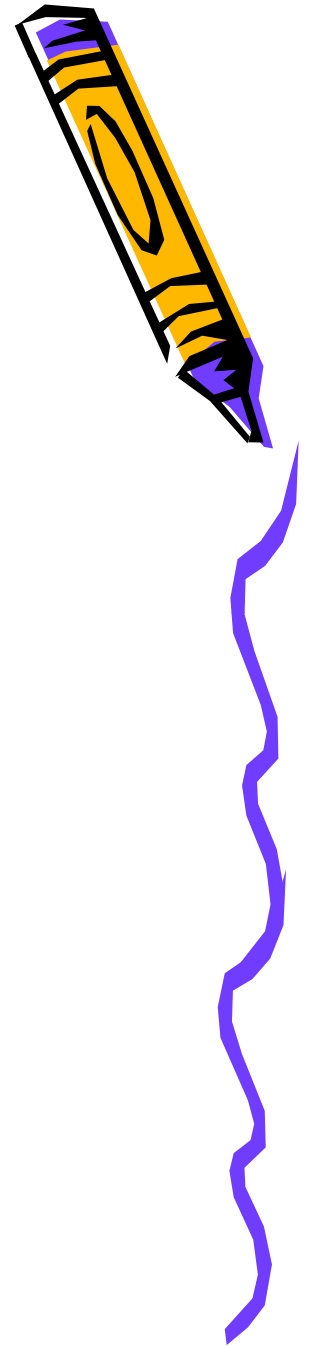
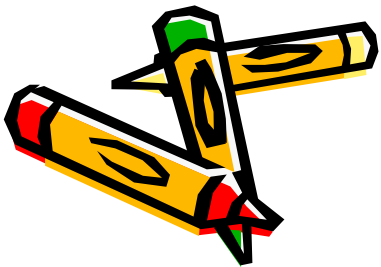
# Emergency Food Resources

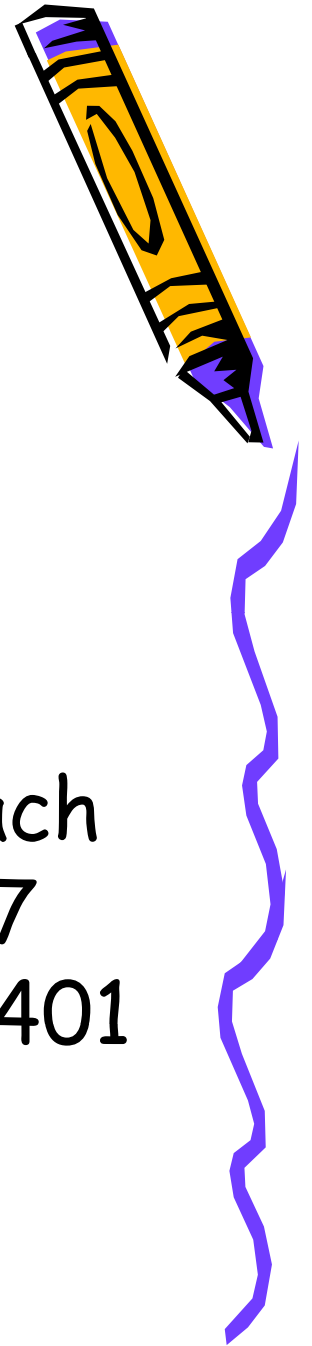
# Anne Arundel County Food and Resource Bank

- Located in Crownsville- agency supplies many food pantries in county, but in emergency, family can be referred directly to the Food Bank



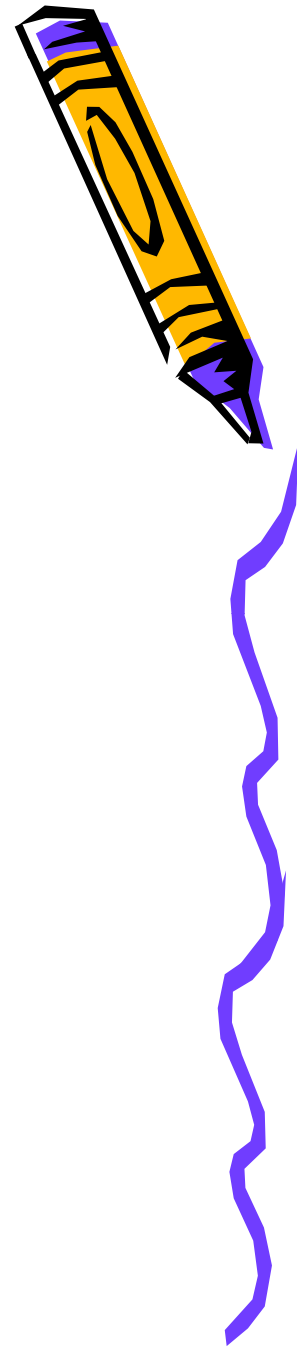
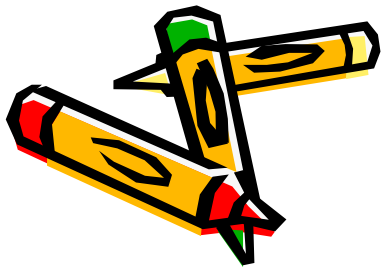

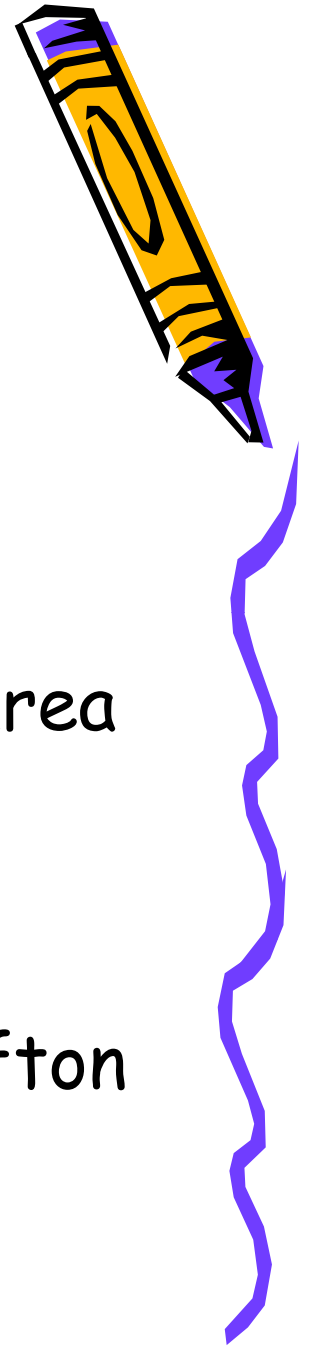
# CAP - Christian Assistance Program, Inc. of the First Evangelical Lutheran Church

- Food available Tuesdays 11-1 and Thursdays 3-5, family limit 1X month - although exceptions sometimes made if referred



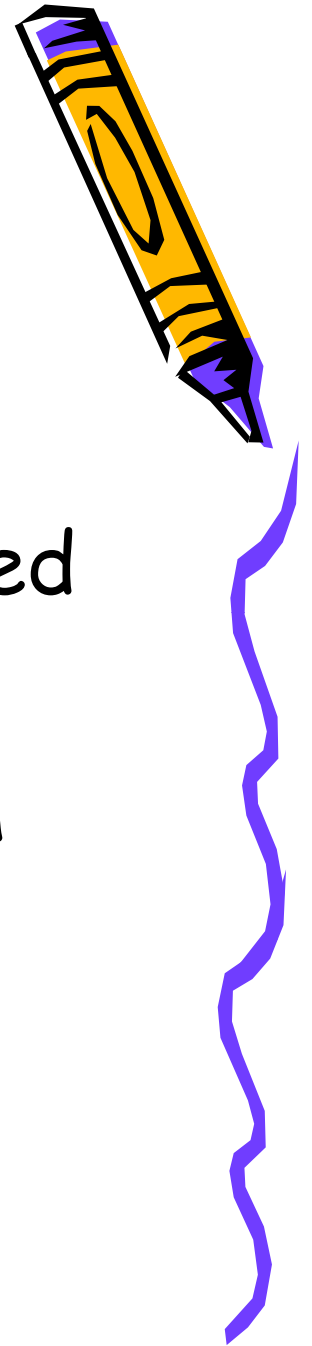

# Emergency Financial Resources

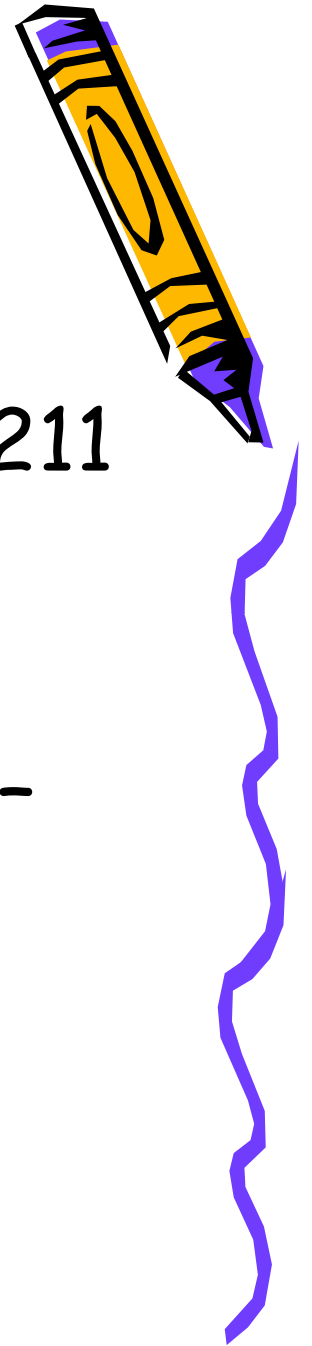
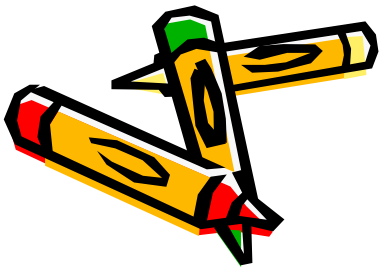
