  - Test-in option
- An average of "B" or better in qualifying courses.
- Passing scores on PRAXIS I and PRAXIS II (*Secondary Content area or Elementary Education Content*) ([www.ets.org](http://www.ets.org))
- Rigorous interview process
- Writing sample
- Professional letters of recommendation
- AACPS employment eligibility requirements
