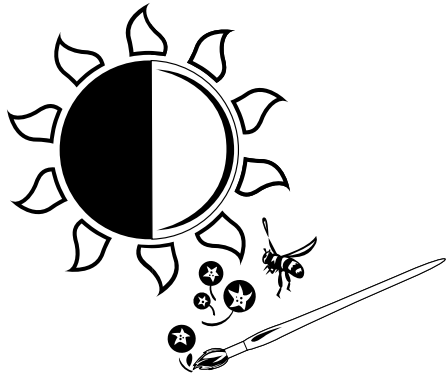

Parents Are the First Teachers

Research is clear that the most important thing a family can do for their child is to encourage learning. This is more important than family education or income. Developing reading skills are dependent upon this family commitment. Here are some helpful tips for reading with your child:

- Read aloud to your child regularly
- Recognize your children interests
- Let your child select books to read
- Let your child turn the pages
- Sit close together
- Ask questions about what is happening
- Reread the book if your child chooses
- Have a regular time for reading together
- Suggest books related to their interests
- Share stories together
- Go to the library
- Use time in the car for interactive conversation
- Read newspapers and magazines
- Talk about the pictures
