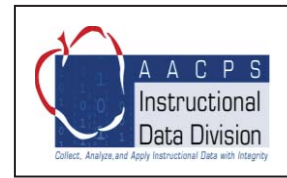

**Principal:** Linda Chandler (17 yrs. AACPS, 3 yrs. principal, 3 yrs. current school)

**Building:** Occupied 1975 (new school planned for Southgate Park; opening in 24-25)

- First STEM middle school in AACPS; has maximized STEM enrollment each year and received national STEM distinction
- School has county's only autism program in a comprehensive middle school.
- One walking community; all other students are eligible bus riders
- One of three schools in same-building complex (but moving in 2024 to new school in nearby Southgate Park)
- Students completing changemaker projects each year that make a direct impact on school community (many have received state and national recognition)
