

Dress Code

Dress Appropriately

Create a respectful and safe environment in school.

Headwear · Only for health, safety, or religious reasons

Shoes · No bare feet

Clothing · Cannot show profanity, obscenity, violence, or symbols of hate
· Cannot promote alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
· Cannot promote gang colors or gang-related signs
· Cannot show underwear
· Cannot show bare skin between upper chest and mid thigh

Examples of inappropriate dress:

- baseball caps
- tank tops
- midriffs
- tobacco or alcohol brand T-shirts
- pajama bottoms

You cannot wear clothes that create a disruptive environment or cause a health or safety hazard.



Skirts/Shorts must be to the mid thigh

Tops must conceal student so that no bare skin is showing below mid-chest. Cleavage must be covered.



No hats in school except for verified medical, safety, or religious reasons.



Tank tops are not permitted. A sweater/ shirt may be worn over the top of a tank.

Pajama bottoms and slippers are not permitted in school.



Students who violate the dress code will be asked to change clothes. Students can borrow gym uniforms from the administration or call home for a change of clothing.
