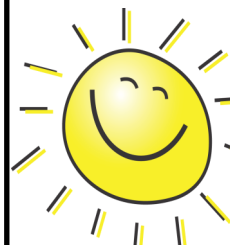

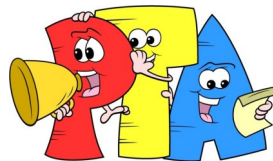

## ★ Health Room Reminder ★

The end of the year has arrived! We thank you for allowing us to care for your children this year! **If your child has medication in the health room, please pick it up on June 14th before 1:30 pm. All medicine MUST be picked up by Monday, June 17th at 10am.** After this time, it will be discarded.

## Summer Vaccinations

If your child receives any vaccinations this summer, please send a copy of the shots to the middle school. **By 7th grade, or when your student turns 11 years old, he/she is required to have a meningitis vaccine and a Tdap vaccine.** If your student has already received these, please let the health room know now so we can update their record. Thank you!

Four Seasons Elementary School is equipped with a video camera system. It covers selected interior and exterior public portions of the building and grounds. It is NOT monitored constantly, but it is monitored during emergency situations.

During certain events, when the safety or security of students may be in question, authorized personnel from local, state or federal police or fire emergency units may be given access to view images projected on the camera system.
