## Principal's Message

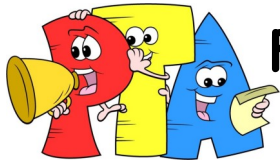

### Outdoor Recess:

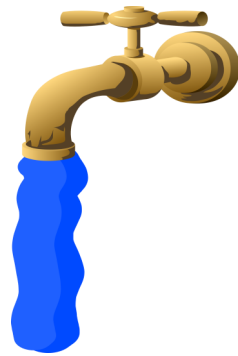
Cold weather is now here. We try to go out for recess as much as we can. Please make sure your child is dressed appropriately to enjoy outside activities.

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## BOX TOPS MAKES IT EASY.

All you need is your phone! Download the Box Tops app, shop as you normally would, then use the app to scan your store receipt within 14 days of purchase. The app will identify Box Tops products on your receipt and automatically credit your school's earnings online.

There are very few clip boxtops on boxes, but if you find a boxtop with a red dotted line around it, clip it and bring it in to Four Seasons. Go to [boxtops4education.com](http://boxtops4education.com) for more information.

### BOX TOPS CLIPS



If you discover a traditional Box Tops clip on a product, you can still clip it and send it to school. **Every valid Box Tops clip is still worth 10¢ for your school.** Make sure each one you turn in has a clearly visible product acronym and expiration date.

\* All valid Box Tops clips submitted per the Program Rules to an eligible, enrolled school(s) will be honored.

### BOX TOPS LABELS



If you see this label on a product, you can use the Box Tops app to scan your receipt. The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online. Please note that some Box Tops products are not labeled; check our product list for a complete list of participating products.
