

Violations: No student shall be considered in violation of the school's mandatory uniform policy if the parent/guardian secures an exemption for the student from the building administrator for any one of the following reasons:

- a. Violates religious belief;
- b. Creates financial hardship; and
- c. Conflicts with the wearing of a nationally recognized youth organization uniform (e.g. Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts) on meeting days, during scout week, etc.

Violations of the uniform policy will be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the Anne Arundel County Public Schools Code of Student Conduct.

Uniform Assistance: The Jessup Administration along with the PTA Executive Board will create a plan to financially assist families unable to purchase uniforms. They will also design an exchange program to promote exchanging of outgrown uniforms.

*****Exemption:** At this time, every school day will be considered a uniform day unless designated by an administrator as Spirit Day. Parents will be given advance notice of any Spirit Day.
