

## **HYBRID ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL**

### **ARRIVAL: 8:10 am**

All students will receive a transportation tag identifying them as walker, bus rider or car rider. Car riders will also receive a hang tag for your car. Please write your child's first and last name on this for us and hang on your rearview mirror.

**Walkers-** report to the cafeteria/playground door and will be greeted by staff to enter through this door. They will be escorted to class in socially distanced lines as they come in.

**Bus Riders-** normal routine. Dropped off in front of building on Melvin Avenue. Staff will greet and sort students to enter through the main doors in social distanced lines.

**Car Riders-** the car rider lane for this school year only, will be on Monterey Street in the back of the school at the gym doors. It is the same place we have been doing drive through materials pick-ups. Students will be greeted by staff members and taken into the gym. They will be escorted to class in socially distanced lines as they come in.

All students will be served breakfast by AACPS in their classrooms before instruction begins at 8:30am. Students will eat breakfast BEFORE 8:30 instruction. Please allow time.

**Walkers-** K-1 will exit with staff through the cafeteria/playground doors. Parents, please wait patiently at the fence line so that we may bring your children to you. 2-5 students will exit from the upstairs front art door and walk to the sidewalk/fence line to meet their families. They will also be escorted by staff.

**Bus Riders-** will exit by K-1, 2-3, 4-5 to board their buses in socially distanced lines from the main entrance.

**Car Riders-** will be called by the order of cars lined up on Monterey at the back of the school. Please make sure your rear-view mirror sign is visible to staff so we can get your students to you in an efficient and safe manner. Staff will have walkie-talkies to radio for your students.
