- Custodial “Internship” day program for select students to prepare them for future employment. NOTE: A Preventative Maintenance “Internship” day program is also being discussed as a possibility.
- Training classroom within Central Special School to provide full custodial training, including all requirements to be fully qualified for hire as a Custodian I in our school system.
