

4th Marking Period QA Waiver for AP and IB Exams

12th grade students who sit for an AP or IB Exam are not required to sit for the 4th marking period QA in that same course. If a student does not sit for the final QA in an AP or IB class, the final grade will be calculated according to the AACPS guidelines by averaging together the two numeric grades for 3rd and 4th marking period. Students who wish to forgo the 4th marking period QA in a course must return this form signed by the student and parent to the teacher, prior to the last day of classes. Students who do not submit the waiver, signed by parents, and fail to take the 4th marking period QA will receive an “E” for the course.
