Is a nonprofit organization that awards scholarships to top performing high school seniors who reside in Anne Arundel County (AAC). Since its inception in 1984, the organization has awarded over \$3,000,000.

Eligibility

Scholarships are awarded to graduating high school seniors who are AAC residents attending public and private schools in AAC and home-schooled students living in AAC. An applicant must have a minimum weighted grade point average, which differs by scholarship. Scholarships are awarded without regard to financial need, race, gender, age, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, or familial status.
