Anne Arundel County Public Schools offers *AVID* (*Advancement Via Individual Determination*) to Middle and High School students. *AVID* is an accelerated academic program designed to provide academic instruction and support to students “in the middle” to prepare them for eligibility to four-year colleges and universities.

Tutors Needed

AVID tutors are needed to facilitate small groups of students during the *AVID* Tutorials. *AVID* tutors volunteer for a minimum of one hour per week, during regular school hours, at one of our *AVID* sites. *AVID* tutors would commit to at least one semester of tutoring in one of our 19 middle schools or 12 high schools.
