

SENIOR PARKING REGISTRATION- 2019-2020

Anne Arundel County Public Schools- Meade High School
INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS- PLEASE RETAIN FOR YOUR RECORDS.

- An assigned permit is valid only for the 2019-2020 school year. Class of 2020 Seniors will be notified if they received a space by August 26th. At that time, we will let you know when the mandatory parking class will be. Class of 2020 Seniors who are awarded parking MUST attend ONE of the required orientations. All applications and \$30 parking fee must be turned in to Ms. Carter by August 12th.
- ****Outstanding Obligations = No Parking Permit**** (This includes textbooks, class dues, unpaid parking tickets etc.)
- Due to the limited parking spaces at Meade High School and the number of students in the Class of 2020, parking is limited and assigned first to Class of 2020 Seniors involved in priority programs, which are defined by Board of Education Policy JGA as school-based early release programs (see Policy JGA for all parking guidelines):
 - School credited off-site work/intern programs (not after-school jobs)
 - ECAP-Early College Access Program (must show proof of applicable enrollment and payment)
 - Vo-Tech (off-site students only- not CAT-South students)
 - JROTCAny remaining spaces will then be assigned to Class of 2020 Seniors in the following order:
 - Participation in an extra-curricular activity in the current semester (verification will be conducted).
 - Minimum GPA of 2.0
 - All other seniors, through a lottery system.
- Only completed applications received by the deadline will be eligible for priority programs. Parking applications must be submitted to Ms. Carter no later than August 12, 2019. Class of 2020 Seniors who submit applications after the cut-off will be assigned parking spaces based upon availability, not by priority programs. Once all available spaces have been assigned, those seniors remaining will be placed on a waitlist. As spaces become available, they may be assigned via lottery.
- While on the waitlist, any parking violations will result in the student's removal from the list. Underclassmen who park illegally and seniors with unpaid parking violations will not be eligible for a parking permit.
- Seniors may lose their parking privileges if they violate the Meade Code of Conduct or violate parking regulations. Specifically see #11- Parking Rules & Regulations.
- Only Class of 2020 Seniors with a valid driver's license may apply. Those who have a learner's permit may not submit applications for parking permits until they actually have a valid driver's license. The student's vehicle must also be registered to them, their parents, or their guardian.

PARKING INFRACTIONS: Reckless driving; Parking without a permit; Parking in an unauthorized area. Any other action deemed unsafe by administration.

CONSEQUENCES:

1st Violation - \$15.00 ticket and may result in vehicle being towed at owner's expense

2nd Violation - \$15.00 ticket, loss of parking privileges for one semester and vehicle may be towed at owner's expense

3rd Violation - \$15.00 ticket, loss of parking privileges for the entire school year, towing may occur at owners expense

Any violation may result in action taken by Ft. Meade Military Police Department as well.

TO APPLY, PLEASE COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

1. This form (front and back) fully completed and signed by both student and parent/guardian;
 2. A photocopy of the CURRENT registration and driver's license and parking fee of \$30 (cash, check or online school payment program – link found on meadeseniorhigh.org.
- Applications must be submitted no later than August 12, 2019.
 - All applications must be submitted to Ms. Carter. Late applications will NOT qualify for priority programs (Work Study/Intern, ECAP (formerly Jump Start), Vo-Tech, JROTC) and will go into the lottery system.
 - All Early College Access Program (ECAP) students must be registered by August 12, 2019 in order to qualify. You must provide a copy of class schedule and receipt of payment with your application. Classes held at MHS, on weekdays, starting after 3:00 pm, and non-academic core classes do NOT qualify as ECAP.
 - If any of the above items are missing, incomplete, or instructions are not followed, the application will not be processed.
 - Students who have a learner's permit are not eligible for a parking permit. Upon getting a valid driver's license, students may submit an application; if after August 12, 2019, they will be placed on a waitlist if no spaces are available.

Meade High School Student Parking Rules & Regulations

Student Parking on Meade High School campus is a privilege reserved for Class of 2020 Seniors with valid permits only.

1. A fee of \$5 will be charged for the replacement of lost or stolen permits or to obtain a permit for a new vehicle.
2. Vehicles brought onto school grounds must be operated in a safe manner. Speed limit on campus is 15 mph. Driving/parking on walkways or grassy areas is prohibited. Vehicles must yield to school buses and pedestrians. Only front/face in parking is permitted (no backing in).
3. Seniors who finish their curriculum at Meade early will have their space reassigned to a student on the waitlist.
4. Parking permits must be clearly displayed. Permits must be kept up to date; if a new vehicle is purchased to replace the one registered, Administration must be notified immediately. A photocopy of the new vehicle's registration card must be given to Ms. Carter for the permit to remain valid.
5. Permits are valid only for the vehicle registered and are non-transferable between students or vehicles!
6. Student parking is restricted to the student parking lots and the student's assigned parking space only. Students are not permitted to park in no parking zones, faculty parking lots, visitor spaces, handicapped spaces, the bus lanes or on the grass. Student vehicles parked anywhere except their assigned spaces are subject to a ticket and/or towing without further warning and at the owner's expense, risk and inconvenience.
7. Only Seniors with a valid driver's license may apply for a parking permit (learner's permit holders are not eligible)!
8. The parking lots are OFF LIMITS during the school day. All vehicles parked on school lots must be locked. Meade High School is not responsible for loss of property inside vehicles nor is Meade High School responsible for damage to vehicles while parked on campus. If your vehicle is damaged, contact Ft. Meade police at 301-677-6622. Vehicles are not to be used as lockers; students will not be permitted to go to their vehicles during the day (including lunch periods) unless permission to do so is obtained in advance from a school administrator.
9. Smoking in vehicles, as on all school grounds, is prohibited, as are the possession, use, and/or distribution of alcohol or drugs. Regular school rules regarding tobacco, alcohol, drugs and weapons apply to vehicles, student parking lots, and all areas of the school's grounds.
10. All student vehicles parked on school grounds may be searched by school administrators (see "Pledge" below).
11. Students may have their parking privileges revoked if they violate parking rules, operate their vehicles in an unsafe manner, or fail to observe the Meade High School Code of Conduct (tardiness, excessive absence, class cuts, lack of academic progress, obligations, etc). Violation of the above regulations may also lead to disciplinary action including suspension from school and/or the towing of student vehicles.

The following pledge is to be read and signed by student & parent before a student may drive and park a motor vehicle on school property: In consideration of the privilege of parking and operating a motor vehicle on school property, I hereby consent to a search of my motor vehicle at any time while it is on school grounds by a school principal or assistant principal upon the determination that a reasonable belief exists to support the necessity of a search. All vehicle searches will be made in the presence of a third party. I fully understand that I cannot be compelled to permit to a search and that, if I refuse to allow a search of my motor vehicle, the school administration may suspend my privileges to park and operate a motor vehicle on school property for the remainder of the school year or for such other length of time as the school administration shall deem appropriate. I agree to support all school rules and regulations regarding the operation and parking of vehicles on school property.
