NOTE: This does not follow a Monday through Friday pattern, but rather a rotating A-Day/B-Day pattern.

### Learning Support Time Block – Core Courses:

Our middle school students require a learning schedule that allows for small group learning or facilitated guided practice using Google Meet. As a result, the learning day has been divided into two sets of alternating core subjects and two encore subjects. New learning will occur for most subjects on a rotating A/B Day schedule. For example, English/Language Arts and Science teachers will facilitate new learning on A-Day and follow-up learning support on B-Day. Math and Social Studies teachers will facilitate new learning on B-Day and follow-up learning support on A-Day. The rotating schedule allows for five new learning opportunities and five secondary learning support opportunities in a two-week period. All classroom teachers are engaging with some students daily during the Learning Support Time.

Please remember, that during Learning Support Time the teacher can provide learning support for small groups, facilitate guided practice, tutor small group of students, host a small group discussion, do a science experiment, go over math problems, analyze a historical document, review a recorded video lesson, etc. Teachers do not have to do direct instruction during the 1.5 hours of Learning Support Time.

You may not see all your students every day, or even every A or B day. This time is for you to support student learning with targeted groups or with students who ask for your help; we are not requiring that you interact face-2-face in Google Meet with each of your students daily or every other day. But, we do expect that you will use Google Meet to work with small groups of some of your students routinely throughout each week.

### Learning Support Time Block - Encore Courses:

Encore teachers will also follow the A-Day/B-Day schedule with learning support on a rotating schedule. The only exception to this is for World Language teachers who teach a daily course. In these cases, new learning material should only be posted on A days. Learning support for Encore will be offered according to the typical frequency of the class (Encore courses on A/B day rotationally; every day for World Language courses that are offered daily).

Remember that you may want to record yourself teaching small segments of content to post on your assigned day so your students who do not join your Learning Support Block will still receive your learning support via video. Additionally, when you meet in small groups to hold a discussion, go over problems, teach a concept, please record yourself in Google Meet and post for other students to watch when they are able. This is an expectation we have of all teachers.
