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PROGRAM CURRICULUM

The Mount's M.Ed. courses emphasize the importance of academic research as they prepare you to become an even more effective leader. The program consists of a total of 36 credit hours (12 courses).

The M.Ed. in instructional leadership is for education professionals who are seeking administrative certification in order to pursue leadership roles in their school systems.

SPECIAL ACCREDITATION

All teacher education programs at the Mount are accredited by the Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE). In 2014, Mount St. Mary's University earned accreditation through the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education (NCATE).
