



Prekindergarten Application—Important Information

Applications will be accepted at all prekindergarten program sites, beginning February 5, 2020.

Please note: Public school prekindergarten programs in Maryland must serve children from economically disadvantaged or homeless families. If seats remain after all economically disadvantaged children have been enrolled, the system may enroll children who have other school readiness needs.

Age and Residency Requirements

- Children must be four years of age on or before September 1st of the school year in which they are registering.
- Children must reside in Anne Arundel County.

Enrolling Your Child in Pre-K

You will need to bring the following documents when you apply:

- Documentation of income eligibility for Category 1 applicants only:
 - Most recent Federal Income Tax Return (1040)
 - or**
 - A current Food Stamp Award Letter
 - or**
 - A current Temporary Cash Assistance Award Letter
 - or**
 - Proof of Foster Care income
- Your child's original birth certificate
- A copy of your child's immunization record (Check immunization requirements at www.cdc.gov/vaccines)
- Proof of residency in Anne Arundel County
 - Lease/mortgage document **and** a current telephone bill or utility bill or income tax/property tax notice
 - or**
 - A notarized Tenant Verification Form (available at all schools)

Homeless Students

Homeless students have the right to enroll immediately.

Head Start

A current Federal Income Tax Return (1040) is required for Head Start enrollment.
