

## Who We Are

The Office of Psychological Services staffs approximately 80 school psychologists and is continually growing. We are supervised by a Coordinator who is trained as a school psychologist.

A strong emphasis is made on broader role of the school psychologist: consultation, counseling, crisis intervention, not just assessments. We continually strive towards NASP ratios; current school psychologists have one to two schools assigned to them per year and there are opportunities to change schools/assignments periodically. The use of technology, including online assessment tools, helps to increase testing efficiency.

"New to AACPS" school psychologists are provided mentors as well as regularly scheduled meetings with other new colleagues for transition help and support.

We promote strong collegial values, where colleagues support each other. Staff with shared interests often form workgroups to help advance new ideas. We strive for an emphasis on work-life balance.

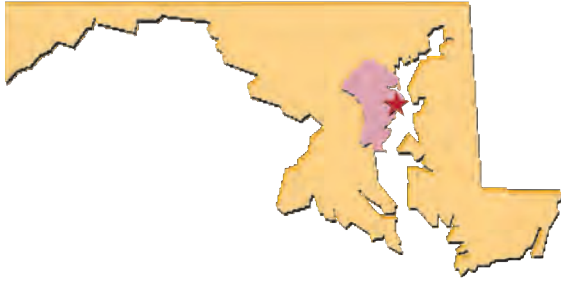


## Professional Development and Advocacy
