7:00 pm Meeting Called to Order and Roll Call by Chair [16 Committee member present]

- Minutes from previous meeting approved [motion to accept made by Stacey Montagne, Jocelyn Newell seconded the motion]

Committee Chair, Jonathan Boniface, clarified the role of the committee, and addressed the Public regarding positive comments, and negative comments received by community members.

Stacey Montagne made motion to move agenda item, “Public Comments”, to the end of the session; Kristen Caminiti seconded the motion

Comments Scott Schuler, AACPS Student Demographics and Planning Specialist:

- Began discussion regarding a review of the numbers. AACPS has not opened a new High School in a long time [over 2 decades] Initially AACPS was looking at a *soft opening*; entrance of 9th-10th grade. Thanked parent, Samantha, for emailed suggestion.
- 2022-2027 numbers projection was the initial focus of this committee Historically AACPS looked at current year [2018]; asking the question, would the communities/districting line fit into the school TODAY?
 - Once this question is answered, It then becomes AACPS’s job to respond to the school growth that occurs after 2018
- Going forward this Committee is charged to look at the current, 2018, student numbers in terms of redistricting communities that will fit into Crofton High School.
 - Expectation is that it will make this a simpler process with minimizing the numbers to 2018.

8pm Recommendation from the Committee

“Four Feeder” Redistricting Plan:

- Redistrict all Crofton Elementary School and Crofton Middle School students on the west side of Rt. 3 (areas 1038A, 1038B, & 1038C) to Piney Orchard Elementary School and Arundel Middle School, beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.

- Redistrict all high school students in the Nantucket Elementary School and Crofton Elementary School boundaries on the east side of Rt. 3 to Crofton High School beginning in the 2020-2021 school year.
- Redistrict all high school students in the Crofton Meadows and Crofton Woods elementary schools' boundaries to Crofton High School beginning in the 2020-2021 school year.

Additional Recommendations:

1. AACPS conduct a feasibility study for Arundel Middle School to expand capacity and determine the need for either an addition or replacement.
2. AACPS expedite the building of West County Elementary School for students in neighborhoods 1038 A/B/C that are temporarily redistricted to Piney Orchard Elementary School.
3. AACPS grandfather rising 3rd and 4th graders from Crofton Elementary School and rising 7th graders at Crofton Middle School, beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.
4. AACPS build an addition onto Crofton High School in the future to alleviate overcrowding.

8:21pm Public Comments:

Marleah Danerque – Nantucket School currently, and lived in Piney before; experienced redistricting; apologized for negative social media comment. Life experience of being an Army brat, with lots of moves. Moved here to Crofton for stability. Thank you to the Committee for time and consideration

Sarah Berry– Nantucket School; thank you for considering all the options and time taken. I hope you vote in favor of recommendations shared

Steve Skippen – Nantucket School; moved to Crofton 20 years ago. Bought house, dog, had kids. If redistricting happens the way it was stated, I will leave a random thank you

Matt Lake – Walden Community; was planning to address keeping families together. Recommend keep the recommendations, vote for what's best of the majority

Jessica Vallone – husband grew up in Crofton Woods, I'm from Davidsonville; Love the recommendation for keeping the schools together. It will be great in 2020 to have the communities together in one school

Kalyee Burkett – Crofton Elementary; Friends were nervous about not being together, but after hearing recommendation thank you! Crofton Kids have been part of Crofton Community. Nantucket is a special part of the community, and valuable part of Crofton.

Alex Mitchell 7th grader Crofton Middle; had lived in NY with a Best Friend and drifted apart, glad community is being kept together

Lucy Skippen 7th grade Crofton Middle; see that you are trying to keep us together, thank you

Autumn Marks thank you for keeping me, and my Nantucket friends together. Going to Crofton Middle was hard, have made some friends along the way. I'm happy that we will all go to the same Middle and High Schools

Kate Schaeffer 3rd cycle of redistricting; my boys have been at Four Seasons, Nantucket, etc. Part of the early movement for "Let's Build Crofton". We desperately needed a new HS, and to keep Nantucket together. Recommend adding to the recommendations: include an additional Middle School on the West Side. [38 students/class]

Dyanna McMullen – 5th and 1st graders at Piney Orchard; We all want Crofton to stay together. My reservation is HOW OVER CROWDED will Piney Orchard be? If all these developments get built out, the elementary school will be at 150%, built for 600 students; and will house 1000. Arundel Middle built 1961; last renovation 1980's. Did the redistricting numbers include 500 Units in Odenton Town Center? All of this development has been approved with no schools. Steve Schu, and Bill Hager approved these developments. TODAY IS THE LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE. THANK YOU FOR FIGHTING FOR Arundel Middle

Kyle Lusby – 2 children at Nantucket; seems like a logical plan. Will save speech for the Board of Ed

Ron Sroka – Nantucket District; had stats ready, since I was a kids spoke about Crofton HS. This map [presented] makes sense and may take some of the heat of you [Committee]. Was really excited about unloading, but now don't need to.

Lisa Vincent – Parent from Nantucket Elementary; pleading case for Nantucket, and a the Den leader for our Pack from all 4 elementary school. It is important to remember we are a part of greater Crofton. Being together in the community is important to our kids. Apologized for social media issues. Piney Orchard – all this building and no infrastructure; appealed attendees to remember this when voting 11/6

Henry Walsh – Crofton Middle School; can see construction from our school. We have been looking forward to attending, and are looking forward to it

Mandy Conner – PTO, Crofton Meadows Elementary; thank you for taking the time to work on this and keeping our community together. We agree with the recommendations

Ashley Danus – Crofton Meadows PTO and Walden community/Nantucket; Agree with all recommendations that came forward this evening

Nicole Clements – Parent from Crofton Meadows; was here to advocate for school; we can not un-see the projected numbers out there. It is the Committee's responsibility to ensure proper educational structures are in place, safety, being together and over crowding issues still need to be addressed.

Kyle Lewis – New Two Rivers Resident; was a resident at Piney prior to this – our kids go to CES; short straight safe shot to CES. Route to Piney Orchard is a windy unsafe road. This year already students have experienced 4 days of road closure to school, causing for a hour long trip out to Rt 3 to get to POES.

Emily Bakley– Nantucket parent; thank you. Recommendations are what we wanted to hear. Stronger recommendations for additions to the new HS

Nazaree Hines Starr- Crofton Meadows live in Walden; appreciate the recommendations

Christine Rooke - part of 1038 D group; happy with the vote. Any input into widening the road for AACPS. RESPONSE: County Council issue; meets twice a month. Plus, Townhall meetings.

Daniel Rand – Two Rivers 1038B; observed sense of community and great to observe the community advocating for a public school. Committee is in tough position. Relocated into area 2 years, were told from the beginning Crofton school district; change request. Several individuals who bought with Crofton in mind. All about keeping communities together. Grandfather clauses; dig into the statistics to really dissect the numbers

Miriam Morgan – new to area bought home into Two Rivers – our kids have moved frequently. CES; Arundel Middle and High are great schools. What is the plan for the kids that are stuck in Crofton? Can they be moved before 2019? RESPONSE: Yes, Can apply with OAT through AACPS.

Stephanie Mutchler [Committee Member] – TODAY is the last day to register to vote; be sure you are registered

Kristen Caminiti [Committee Member]– recommended Nantucket Elementary to get behind Piney in advocating for their school to be built quicker. Thank you Jonathan for his leadership on this Committee

Sharlee Fleshman [Committee Member]– lived in 1038– need to all come together and make it work.

8:58pm Kristen Caminiti made motion to vote on the above recommendation; Lisa O’Hagan seconded the motion.

After a small debate about moving the vote to next week to permit Committee Members additional time to discuss options, voting commenced:

- 5 - In Agreement
- 10 - Opposed
- 1 - Abstention

Committee will meet next Tuesday October 23, 2018 at Arundel High School to review several redistricting options, identify recommendations, and vote.
