On the heels of an agreement with the Teachers Association of Anne Arundel County (TAAAC), the Board of Education of Anne Arundel County today approved a twoyear agreement with the Association of Educational Leaders (AEL) and a one-year deal with the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) Local 1693, leaving only one employee bargaining unit without a negotiated agreement heading into the start of the new fiscal year.
