



After Hours Course Offerings for STEM Magnet Students



STEM After Hours classes are 0.5 credit classes that STEM students can elect to take after the regular school day ends. They are designed for STEM students who have full schedules or want to provide room in their day schedules to free up opportunity for other coursework.

Some STEM Magnet high schools run these courses annually or on a rotational basis and others have moved to offering seats for STEM students in Evening High School courses or courses at Anne Arundel Community College. Currently, these courses are *free* to STEM students and provide a wonderful opportunity for students to earn additional credit.
