Meeting Minutes November 18, 2019 1:30 PM – 2:30 PM AACPS Board Room

<u>Guiding statement</u>: The purpose of this committee is to identify and initiate updated strategies in the eradication of achievement gaps between student groups.

- Greetings and Introductions were delivered
- Participants participated in an ice breaker activity where they selected an image that reflects how they felt about the work of the joint initiative so far? Purpose of this activity is to help the committee focus on the work. We need a commonality in this space.
- Summaries were provided by subcommittee's analysis of the feedback data from the September 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting. The questions answered for the analysis: What does the data say? Why does the data say that? Now what?
- A definition of SMART goals was reviewed (Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant and Timely) which an emphasis on the "S" (specific) – Create a specific goal

### 6 W Questions when creating the "S" of the SMART goal:

- 1. Who: Who is involved?
- 2. What: What do I want to accomplish?
- 3. Where: Identify a location.
- 4. When: Establish a time frame.
- 5. Which: Identify requirements and constraints.
- 6. Why: Specific reasons, purpose, or benefits of accomplishing the goal.

#### **Next Steps:**

- In moving forward, consider the seven steps in the equity literacy case analysis approach.
