Illness Guidelines

COVID-19 has a wide range of symptoms- from mild symptoms to severe illness and mimics many other illnesses. Students should not enter school if they have any of the following symptoms (even if not tested or confirmed) or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 or with COVID-19-like illness in the last 10 days.

Fever or Chills (Temp>100 F)

Cough

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Fatigue

Muscle or body ache

Headache

New loss of taste or smell

Sore throat

Congestion or runny nose

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Parents should consult with their doctor for advice and/or treatment of the conditions or symptoms listed here.

Always feel free to call the health room with any questions. Please let us know if your child has been out with an illness so we may check on him/her during the school day as needed.

Child may return to school if they meet these 3 criteria:

- 10 days since symptoms first appeared and
- 24 hours with no fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and
- Other symptoms are improving*
