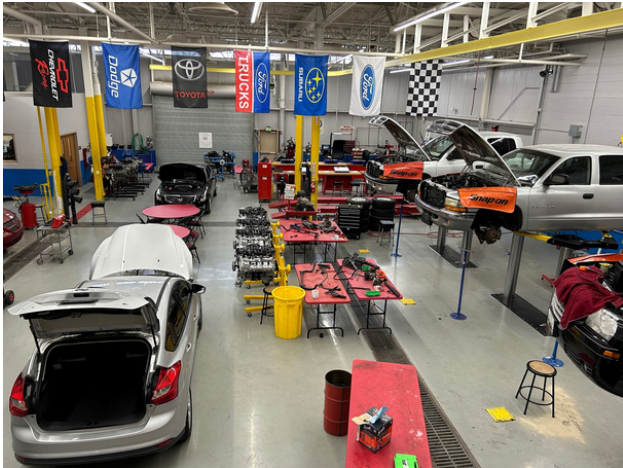


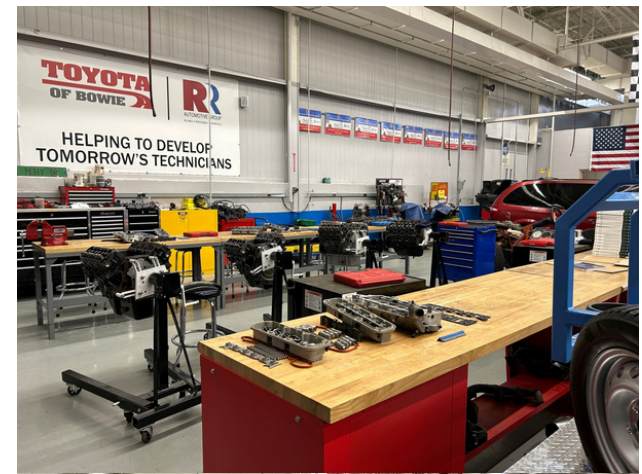

## Automotive Technology



The Automotive Technology program at CAT-South is a two-year program that allows students entering 10th or 11th grade to gain experience in many aspects of the automotive industry. Following current market needs, students learn how to perform service and are tested in the areas of maintenance, assembly and disassembly of components parts, engine components and mechanisms, brake systems, computer diagnostics and diagnostics strategies, electrical systems, engine repair, electronic components, refrigeration and heating, steering, alignment, transmission and drivelines.

The program is certified by the Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) Education Foundation in Maintenance and Light Repair. In addition, all students receive Safety and Pollution Prevention (S/P2) training and certifications in Automotive Mechanical Safety and Pollution Prevention. Students in the Auto Tech program can earn college credits. A work-based learning experience is also offered, often leading to successful careers in the automotive repair industry.
