The BMAH magnet program at Glen Burnie High School is a specialized area of study within the STEM disciplines. Students in **all** school clusters in AACPS who are highly motivated and academically eligible* can apply to study and explore BMAH career opportunities in Bioscience, Aging and Wellness, Bioengineering, Health Information Systems, Public and International Health, and the new addition, Teacher Academy of Maryland, which aims to prepare students who are interested in pursuing a teaching career in the STEM fields. As part of the BMAH program, students learn from a rigorous curriculum.

They count on many community partners to have the opportunity to explore careers within the field, participate in job shadowing days, hear from guest speakers, get support from mentors, and participate in the real-life investigation of medical topics, including human medicine, physiology, genetics, microbiology, and public health, through Project Lead the Way.
