They use a wide array of print and bindery equipment to produce the products they've created. Students learn how to prepare materials and machinery, design, price, and sell their products to organizations and

community partners. Projects include business cards, tickets, programs, brochures, boxes,

packaging, posters, banners, signs, T-shirts, books, stickers, and more.

Upon completing the program, students may receive the following industry certifications: PrintED Introduction to Graphic Communication; PrintED Offset Press/Bindery & Finishing; PrintED Digital Production Printing.
