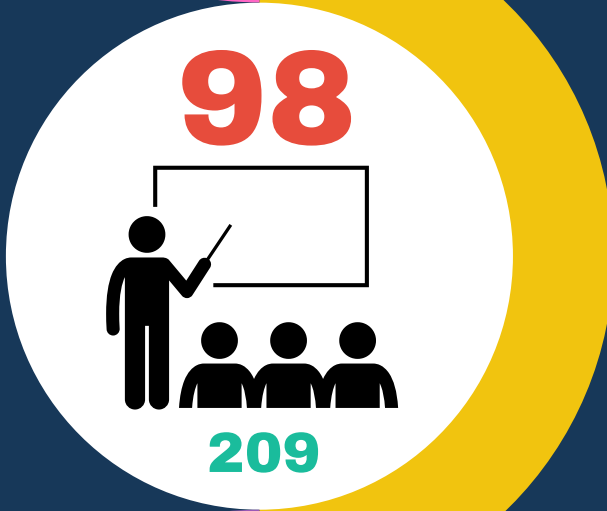
This week's update includes current information regarding critical vacancies (number above the graphic) that impact school operations for the school year.

CLASSROOM TEACHERS

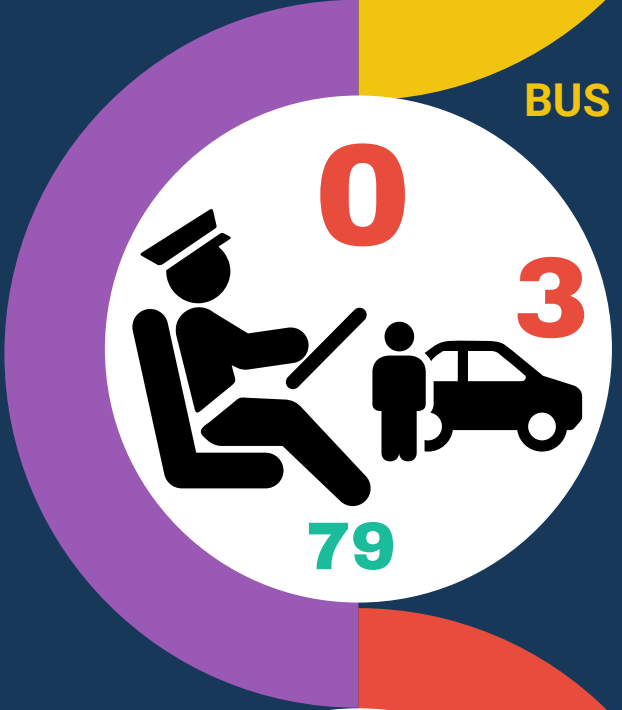
All subject areas and grade levels in addition to other school-based positions are needed.

8 alternative vehicle drivers in training

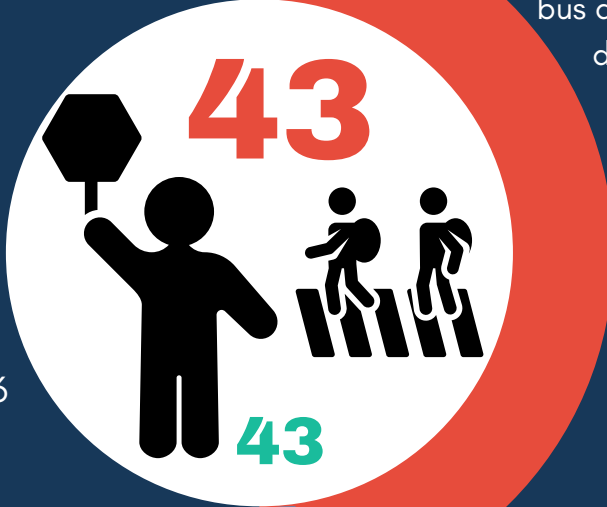

CROSSING GUARDS

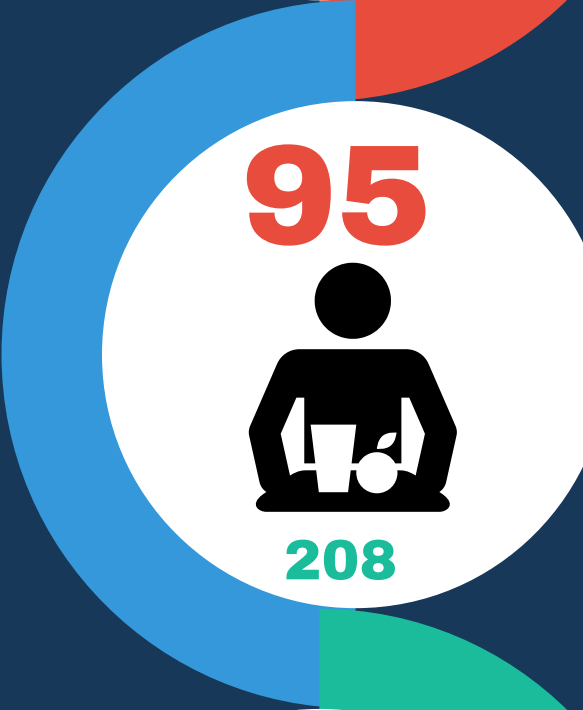
Crossing guards are employees of the Anne Arundel County and Annapolis City police departments.
