

Magnet Program Seat and Wait-List Offer Information Guide 2019

Here are important details about accepting your Magnet Seat Offer and/or accepting your Magnet Wait-List Offer. Some important reminders:

- Students with eligible Magnet applications will receive **either a seat offer** or a **wait-list offer**.
- A separate email for each Magnet Program will be sent and may be sent out on different days.
- Students may stay on the wait-list for a program while accepting a seat offer in a different Magnet Program.
 - You must accept or decline each wait-list seat offer.
 - The wait-list will remain active until the end of September.
 - Movement on the wait-list may occur throughout the summer.
- If after ten calendar days a seat or wait-list offer has not been accepted, the Magnet Office will take the lead in declining that seat for lack of response.
- **The decision to decline a seat on a wait-list or in a Magnet Program is final.**
 - If a seat is declined, the Magnet Office will immediately offer that seat to another applicant.
 - The decision to accept or decline a seat should be a personal decision between applicants and their families.

All students' seat offers are conditional, pending final grades and requirements. Please verify the requirements published for students at the time of application (www.aacps.org/magnet). Students who no longer meet the published criteria cannot accept a seat in a Magnet Program and should enroll at their home school.

The criteria to accept a seat offer and continue to Magnet Program registration:

- Maintained minimum required final course average, with no Ds or Es as a final grade, regardless of program
- Maintained residency in Anne Arundel County
- Attended Magnet Program Welcome and Registration Night
- **High school only- students must have the above in addition to:**

Program	Requirement
BioMedical STEM (BMAH) and STEM	Successful completion of both Math and World Language with a C (70%) or better.
International Baccalaureate (IB MYP DP)	Successful completion of Chinese I, French I, Italian I, or Spanish I with a C (70.0%) or better in the course and a C (76.0%) or better on the exam.
