

ACCESS TO SHELTER IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY

Are you homeless and need shelter tonight?

Anne Arundel County has a Coordinated Entry system for shelter and one list for all shelters in the County. Individuals seeking to be screened for shelter must contact the **Shelter Screening Line at 410-417-7260**. This is a google voice number, please leave a message if the call is not answered. The shelter screening line is answered Monday-Friday from 8a.m.-5p.m. Those seeking shelter after-hours should contact the Crisis Warmline at 410-768-5522.

DSS Street Outreach Team - 443-422-3993

The Street Outreach Team will meet with individuals wherever they are to help them access benefits and resources.

Are you at risk of homelessness? Will you lose your housing in the next two weeks, but do not need shelter tonight?

Call the Systems of Care to receive one-to-one assistance and support over the telephone. Information and referral specialists are available to help callers find local resources including homelessness prevention, mental health services, food, housing, utilities, and more.

Crisis Services Community Warmline

If you are experiencing a crisis, the Crisis Response System at the Anne Arundel County Mental Health Agency can help. Staff intervene with callers who are experiencing a mental health and/or substance use disorder emergency. Non-emergency calls are provided with information, support and referrals. The Community Warmline receives calls 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at 410-768-5522.
