

SCHOOL BOARD APPOINTMENT COMMISSION
OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY
MINUTES OF AUGUST 24, 2017
(Approved November 14, 2017)

The School Board Appointment (SBAC) Commission of Anne Arundel County convened at 7:00 p.m. on the above date at the Carol S. Parham Building, 2644 Riva Road, Annapolis, MD. Commissioners in attendance and their affiliations were: Susannah Kipke, Anne Arundel County Executive appointment and Chair of the SBAC; Allison Pickard, Anne Arundel Council of PTAs, and Vice Chair of the SBAC; Jerry Klasmeier, Anne Arundel Community College; Linda Ferrara, Association of Educational Leaders; Josie Urrea, Chesapeake Regional Association of Student Councils; Estefania Holler, County Council of PTAs; Penny Cantwell, Central Maryland Chamber of Commerce; Ginger Otis Vance, Anne Arundel Chamber of Commerce; Mariko Bennett, Anne Arundel NAACP; Bill Jones, Teachers Association of Anne Arundel County; Nathaly Uribe, CASA de Maryland; and Amalie Brandenburg, County Executive appointment. Leanne Carmona, Special Education Citizen Advisory Committee, was absent.

Staff members present were Bob Mosier, Chief Communications Officer, Anne Arundel County Public Schools; Jeanette Ortiz, Legislative and Policy Analyst, AACPS; and Molly Connolly, Executive Assistant to the Board of Education.

Ms. Kipke opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Ms. Kipke announced the voting procedures that the Commission will use this evening to elect the At-Large Member of the Board of Education, filling a vacant seat with an expiration date of December 2, 2018.

Ms. Kipke asked if there were any changes to the minutes of July 26, 2017, of which there were none. Dr. Ferrara motioned to approve, Mrs. Pickard seconded. The minutes were approved by vote (12-0), Mrs. Carmona absent.

The Commission proceeded with the election process, with Mr. Mosier facilitating the voting. After four rounds of voting, Mr. Colin Reinhard of Linthicum, Md., was appointed to the vacant seat on the Board. Mr. Reinhard received nine votes in the final round, one more than required for appointment.

The commission adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
