SCHOOL BOARD APPOINTMENT COMMISSION
MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 14, 2017

The Anne Arundel County School Board Appointment Commission convened at 7:00 p.m. on the above date at the Dr. Carol S. Parham Building, 2644 Riva Road, Annapolis, Maryland.
